LASER TAG SAFETY BRIEFING FOR PLAYERS

Laser tag is a high-tech game and is much safer than paintball or airsoft. However, even here, no one is completely safe from bruises, contusions, scratches, or more serious injuries.

Therefore, to ensure that you only have positive emotions and pleasant physical fatigue from playing laser tag, you must follow the following basic safety rules on the playing field:

PROHIBITED:

- Participation in the game for individuals with medical contraindications to physical activity.
- Leaving the designated play area.
- Playing in areas of the territory that are closed off by the event organizers (marked with caution tape and indicated to you during the briefing).
- Engaging in physical contact during the game.
- Jumping over or climbing over any obstacles, jumping out of/into windows, crawling through narrow tunnels, stopping by running into a wall or attempting to climb it, etc.
- Being on the playing field while under the influence of alcohol, drugs, toxic substances, etc., or under the influence of medications that affect the central nervous system.

RECOMMENDED:

- Pay attention to all factors that could lead to a fall or injury.
- Immediately inform the organizers about any injuries sustained by players and do not take any independent measures.
- Wear shoes with thick soles and high ankle support during the game.
- Wear clothing made of durable and non-marking fabrics during the game.
- Do not carry small items in pockets that could be lost on the playing field.
- In case of any situation that you consider an emergency, contact the organizers.

If you violate one or several of the above prohibitions or recommendations, the organizers reserve the right to deny you participation in the game event and remove you from the playing field!
